Step 1 Complete Form

Fill in the Application for Admission completely and accurately using a **black ink pen**, or apply online at www.kwantlen.ca/apply

Step 2 Attach Documents

Attach supporting documents (high school or post-secondary transcripts and proof of immigration status). For students currently attending a BC high school, be sure to fill out your "Choices" form to have your high school transcripts sent automatically to Kwantlen, and enter your PEN number on the back page.

All documentation filed in support of this application becomes the property of Kwantlen Polytechnic University and may be retained as part of each student's record.
