Admission Requirements:

Admission to University of British Columbia Faculty of Dentistry requires at least three years (90 credits) of Arts and Science courses. The pre-dental requirements are as follows:

Biology	BIOL 1110 & 1210 ³	No high school prerequisite
Organic Chemistry (6 credits)	CHEM 2320 & 2420	Prerequisite for CHEM 2320: CHEM 1210 or CHEM 1110 (B)
Biochemistry	BIOL 2421 ¹	Prerequisite: BIOL 1110 and 1210 and 2321 and CHEM 2320 Corequisite: CHEM 2420

1. If you take BIOL 2421 to fulfill the biochemistry requirement, you will be missing the equivalent of UBC BIOC 302. Contact UBC for more information.
2. Recommended for students studying life sciences.
3. The Biology requirement may be met with Biology 12 in place of BIOL 1110 & 1210.

The required minimum GPA for all the above university-transfer courses is 70%.

Admission Statistics 2009

- Out of 215 qualified applicants, 120 are selected for an interview for 49 spaces in the program
- The average GPA for students offered a seat was 82.9%
